Personalized Education Program (PEP) Information

PEP Students Welcome

Liberty Scholars welcomes students participating in Florida's Personalized Education Program (PEP) through Step Up For Students. As a Direct Pay provider, we offer individualized instruction in a small classroom environment, certified teachers, progress monitoring, and flexible learning opportunities for eligible families.

Attendance Requirements

PEP students enrolled at Liberty Scholars are expected to attend all scheduled instructional days unless an absence is excused. Parents must notify the school of absences, and students are responsible for completing missed work. The school maintains attendance records in accordance with Florida private school requirements. Excessive absences or lack of participation may result in an attendance conference and could affect continued enrollment.

Parent Responsibilities

Families are responsible for maintaining compliance with Step Up For Students and Florida Department of Education requirements, including maintaining a Student Learning Plan (when applicable), completing required annual assessments, renewing scholarship eligibility, and using scholarship funds only for approved educational expenses.

Annual Assessment

PEP students must complete an approved annual assessment as required by the scholarship program. Liberty Scholars can assist families in understanding approved assessment options and scholarship requirements.
